## *The KPFA and WBAI Stories*

---

- **KPFA (94.1 FM) and WBAI New York (99.5 FM)** and their three sister radio stations were founded by Pacifists in the 1940s through the 60s as independent, progressive voices with diverse points of view. The stations are listener-sponsored and commercial-free.
- The **Pacifica Foundation** owns the five stations. The **Board of Directors** of the Foundation illegally changed its by-laws in February 1999 and has formed a self-selecting, undemocratic and highly corporate Board bent on destroying the progressive programming at the five stations.
- The Board has fired respected managers and programmers at KPFA (summer 1999) and at WBAI (December 2000), censored content of news and public affairs programming, and threatened to sell two of the stations (KPFA and WBAI).
- KPFA, WBAI and their sister stations are vital community assets and offer the alternative opinions that are essential to the democratic process.

## *Why Protest Epstein Becker & Green*

- John Murdock is a Pacifica Board member and also works for the law firm Epstein Becker & Green (with an office at Embarcadero Two, in S.F.). Murdock's firm specializes in "maintaining a union-free workplace" and Murdock is a prime mover in the actions against KPFA and the network.
- To end the threat to KPFA, WBAI and the network, the current Board has to be reconstituted, and a democratically elected Board voted in. Members like John Murdock must be removed from the Board.

## *Why Protest CB Richard Ellis*

- Micheal Palmer is treasurer of the Pacifica Board and works for CB Richard Ellis (with a branch office at Embarcadero West, S.F.). CB Richard Ellis is a multi-national commercial realtor. Palmer has advocated selling the KPFA and WBAI FM frequencies. (KPFA alone is worth an estimated \$65 to \$75 million.)
- To end the threat to KPFA, WBAI and the network, the current Board has to be reconstituted. Members like Micheal Palmer must be removed from the Board.
